

## GLOSSARY OF TERMS

<b>WBP</b>	Weather and Boil Proof - Makes joints resistant to weather, micro organisms, cold and boiling water, steam and dry heat.
<b>FSC</b>	Forestry Stewardship Council.
<b>COC</b>	Chain of Custody.
<b>BB/CC</b>	Grading term for Hardwood Plywood. As BB/CC grade it has two good faces the BB better than the CC.
<b>C+/C</b>	Grading term on Shuttering/ Softwood Plywood. The C+/C grade is good one side plugged and sanded.
<b>CE</b>	Certificate of Europe.
<b>BBA</b>	British board of Agreement.
<b>MR</b>	Moisture Resistant.
<b>PHENOL &amp; FORMALDEHYDE GLUE</b>	It is used in the production of fertilizer, paper, plywood, and urea-formaldehyde resins. Low levels of formaldehyde can cause irritation of the eyes, nose, throat, and skin. It is possible that people with asthma may be more sensitive to the effects of inhaled formaldehyde. This gas occurs whilst cutting of formaldehyde products. Care should be taken by wearing a face mask and goggles.
<b>BS1088</b>	Standard used for Marine Plywood. The main difference between marine plywood to bs1088 and exterior faced plywood is that the core veneers are virtually to the same specification as the face veneer, bonding will also be WBP.
